### Proposal Objective

This proposal presents a strategic initiative to **increase international school participation** in our academic conferences. By establishing partnerships with leading international schools, the initiative **aims to diversify conference attendees, promote cross-cultural academic exchange, and position our events as premier platforms for global education dialogue.** Currently, high school engagement remains limited, yet these institutions represent a valuable network of educators and students eager for meaningful professional development opportunities.

The proposed strategy involves a **three-phase approach:** identifying suitable partner schools through market research, engaging them through targeted outreach and incentives, and integrating them into conference programming via dedicated sessions and speaking opportunities. Successful implementation of this plan is expected to result in a 20–30% increase in international school involvement within two years. This initiative aligns with broader goals of educational inclusivity and innovation, and we invite support in launching and sustaining this effort.
